- 2. Property is associated with an event of importance to the history of the Township, County, Region, Commonwealth or Nation.
- 3. Property embodies an icon associated with an era characterized by a distinctive architectural style.
- 4. Property embodies distinguishing characteristics of an architectural style or engineering specimen.
- 5. Property is the noteworthy work of a designer, architect, landscape architect or designer, or engineer whose work has significantly influenced the historical, architectural, economic, social or cultural development of the Township, County, Region, Commonwealth or Nation.
- 6. Property contains elements of design, detail, materials or craftsmanship with represents a significant innovation.
- 7. Property is part of or related to a commercial center, park, community or other distinctive area which should be preserved according to a historic, cultural or architectural motif.
- 8. Property owes its unique location or singular physical characteristic, representing an established and familiar visual feature of the neighborhood, community or Township.
- 9. Property has yielded, or may be likely to yield, information important in prehistory or history.
- 10. Property exemplifies the cultural, political, economic, social or historical heritage of the community.

Additional Class II Historical Resource Application Suggestions

- 1. Discuss your proposal with appropriate township personnel.
- 2. Be prepared to show a drawing to explain your project at the Hearing.
- 3. Pictures are worth a thousand words!
- 4. Bring a letter of support from neighbors if your request will affect them.
- 5. Familiarize yourself with the Historic Preservation Ordinance. This is available on the Township website, www.newtowntownship.org
- 6. Attend a Historic Preservation Commission meeting to see how the process works.
